Faculty mentors gain insights into how to guide writing skill development and provide constructive feedback.

Graduate students explore how to receive feedback and use it to improve their writing.

Facilitators share strategies to help define writing project expectations, to help move projects forward smoothly, and to support the growth of the graduate student writer over time.

Each faculty advisor can attend with up to two graduate students (from any program).

Faculty and graduate students commit to completing: 1) the MAY and APRIL workshops, 2) a writing/feedback assignment--aligned with their existing research, 3) a short feedback consultation, and 4) intake and exit surveys.
