Program Summary: CSU *Writes* is a research writing support program for graduate students, postdoctoral fellows, and faculty who write for degree completion and publication at Colorado State University. Through workshops, fostered writing groups, intensive writing retreats, "show up & write." sessions, consultations, guest presenters, and more, CSU *Writes* helps shepherd the building of expertise and communication skills of CSU academics. We are part of a diverse community of research and scholarly writers who write early, often, better, together.
